Intel/Charles E. Young Endowed Chair

The Intel Foundation has established an endowment to fund an Eminent Scholar Chair in UF's Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering. The endowment honors Charles E. Young, Ph.D., who served as president of the University of Florida from 1999-2004.

Candidates for the endowed chair appointment must have a Ph.D. in electrical and computer engineering or in a related discipline. The candidate must have demonstrated a record of exemplary achievement in their field of research. Successful applicants are expected to be dynamic, visionary and to lead faculty in significant funded research activity. Responsibilities include research, teaching and service. The appointment will be at the level of Eminent Scholar. Areas of particular interest are computer engineering, electronics, and semiconductor devices and technology.

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering has 44 tenure and tenure-track faculty. It is among the largest departments — 662 undergraduate students enrolled in fall 2005.
